SUBJECT: ANNUAL AEROSPACE EDUCATION COMPETITION

1. This is to officially announce that New York Wing will once again host an “*Aerospace Education Display Competition*” at the annual Wing Conference, which will take place from 24-6 April 20 at the Fort William Henry Resort in Lake George.
2. The Aerospace Education team has decided that this event will have a different theme selected every year. This year’s theme is “*History of the U.S. Air Force.*” Given CAP’s inclusion as part of the “*Total Force*” concept, this seemed like an appropriate topic.
3. Group Commanders should highly encourage their Squadrons to participate. The Wing’s desire is that each Group have at least have one display, but if there is additional interest more than one display per Group will be welcomed. Squadrons can work together if that is the most effective way for smaller units to create a display. Also, teams are not limited to two Senior Members and six Cadets like in years past, use whatever personnel required.
4. All activities related to the creation of a display must be conducted in strict compliance with the revised CAPR 60-2, dated 1 November 2019.
5. Teams should use the “*New York Wing Conference Aerospace Education Display Competition*” guidelines that were last revised in 2019.
