NEW YORK WING- FY22 OBJECTIVES

- **Maintain Mission Focus:**
 - **Meet all CAP-USA, 1st AF, and HQ-CAP taskings**
 - **Meet all customer (ANG, NYS Police, etc) requests**
 - **If requested, support NYS Office of Emergency Management**
- **Safely Execute Mission:**
 - **Zero aircraft/sUAS mishaps**
 - **3 incidents reported in SIRS in FY21**
 - **Zero vehicle mishaps**
 - **1 incidents reported in SIRS in FY21**
 - **10% reduction in all other safety related mishaps**
 - **4 incidents reported in SIRS in FY21**
- **Emphasize/foster Senior Member Professional Development:**
 - **Encourage member participation in Volunteer University**
 - **Continue to grow Organization Excellence Committee**



NEW YORK WING- FY22 AEROSPACE EDUCATION GOALS

- Increase the number of Squadrons that earn the Squadron Aerospace Education Achievement Award (SAEAA) by 40%:
 - *21 Squadrons earned the SAEAA in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 29 Squadrons earning the SAEAA*
- Increase the number of Squadrons that order STEM kits from NHQ and complete the evaluation report by 20%:
 - *24 Squadrons ordered STEM kits and completed the evaluation reports in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 29 Squadrons ordering STEM kits and completing evaluation reports*
- Increase the number of Squadrons that complete the Aerospace Excellence Award (AEX) by 25%:
 - *26 Squadrons completed the AEX program in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 32 Squadrons completing the AEX program*



NEW YORK WING- FY22 CADET PROGRAM GOALS

- Increase the number of powered Cadet O-Flights by 10%:
 - *250 front seat powered O-Flights in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 275 front seat powered O-Flights*
- Increase the number of Cadets earning the Wright Brothers Milestone Award by 20%
 - *89 Cadets earned the Wright Brothers award in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 107 additional Cadets earning the Wright Brothers Award*
- Double the number of Squadrons earning the Quality Cadet Unit Award (QCUA):
 - *13 Squadrons earned the QCUA in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 26 Squadrons earning the QCUA*
- Increase the number of Cadets completing the General Emergency Services Test (GES-116) by 20%:
 - *159 Cadets completed GES-116 in FY21*
 - *Goal for FY22 is 191 additional Cadets completing GES-116*



NEW YORK WING- FY22 EMERGENCY SERVICES GOALS

- **Maintain key position current end strength in the IC, Branch Director, and Section Chief positions by holding virtual table top exercises.**
 - ***IC1 (1), IC2 (5), IC3 (10), AOBD (25), GBD (25)***
- **Maintain current Aircrew numbers by (MP, MO, MS, AP) by encouraging training to fly mission sorties in support of SQTR sign-offs.**
 - ***MP (25), MO (50), MS (50), AP (20)***
- **Maintain current GTM and UDF numbers by encouraging Groups to hold outdoor training classes and mission sorties.**
 - ***GTM (100), UDF (75)***
- **Grow AP trained aircrew members by 5, a 20% increase.**
