



Simulator Issues

Not being connected to the *Redbird Navigator* network:

- Check your WiFi settings and make sure it says *Redbird-Navigator-xxx*.

Emergency Stop Button next to pilot's left knee may have been accidentally pushed in:

- Pull out to reset.

One of the Circuit Breakers is popped:

- During startup it is common for one of the circuit breakers to pop. Check and reset.

Panel not connected:

- You can see if the panel is connected in the Sim Management Tab on the Navigator Springboard. Scroll to the bottom and select Devices. Avionics Panel (and everything else) should have a green check. ✓
- Reset the panel by unscrewing it, pull it straight out but not off, reset, and be careful not to overtighten the screws. Just twist enough to hold the panel in place.

Airplane won't run:

- Follow the airplane checklist. It could be something as simple as the mags or fuel selector being off.

If all of these don't work:

- Return to the Navigator Springboard by pressing Home.
- Select Sim Management.
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and select Restart.
- Allow the sim to reboot, return to the Dispatch page, and follow the sim and airplane checklists.
