* ICs, PIOs, CISM Team Members, CULs, MROs, GTLs, and GTMs can supervise personnel to the level that they are trained or lower because of their experience and training. For example, a ground team member level two can supervise a ground team member level three or two, but not a ground team member level one.

** Aircrew members maintain their Water Survival qualification by completing a refresher water survival course once every three years. There is not a separate supervisor requirement. The instructor need only be current themselves.

+ ICs, Section Chiefs, Branch Directors, and Communications Unit Leaders are allowed to serve as supervisors of remote personnel for documentation of qualifications, but should not do so unless they can verify that tasks were actually accomplished.

++ Mission Pilots maintain their Mountain Flying Certification by completing a refresher mountain flying clinic as directed in CAPR 60-1.
