

QUICK START GUIDE TO NEW EDUCATION & TRAINING PROGRAM

Key Information

- Launches on August 4, 2020
- Blended learning model with online and in-person classes at Squadron, Group, Wing, and Region
- SLS, OBC, CLC, RSC, NSC, UCC replaced with new material and learning objectives
- Emphasis on mentoring at every level
- Just-in-time online training for Commanders
- All instructors trained by Volunteer University
- Specialty Track and activity attendance requirements remain the same

ALIGNS WITH CAP STRATEGIC PLAN

Objective 4.1: Perpetuate a culture where CAP volunteers aspire to leadership positions and have the training and tools to be successful. The primary strategy is to implement CAP's completely redesigned professional development program.

NEW PRE-MEMBERSHIP TOPICS

Provides conversation ideas for a potential member's first three meetings

Ensures potential member knows what they are joining and what the expectations are of CAP membership

NEW LEARNING PATHS IN LEVEL II

Core modules that everyone completes, plus one of four Paths designed to tailor learning to the volunteer

1. Current/Former Military
2. Former Cadet
3. Professional Receiving Advanced Grade
4. New Member

NEW INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNIQUES AND TIMELINES

Online courses taken in cohorts and delivered through eServices

In-person or online live instruction will take place at all echelons

Weekend and week-long training events at Group and Wing

Members may choose to work towards their next level entirely online, or with a mix of online and in-person courses

NEW INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

All instructors (even those providing Level I to new members) must apply to Volunteer University and will be trained and mentored to ensure instruction is of uniformly high quality

SHORT TRANSITION TIMELINE

Members working towards Level II must finish under old rules within three (3) months, Level III within six (6) months, and Levels IV or V within nine (9) months, or they lose PD school credit (SLS and OBC for Level II, CLC for Level III, etc)
