

A NOTE ABOUT STUDENT SELECTION PROCESS:

For the past few years we have had more applications than can be accommodated at our facility. As such we will accept cadets based on the following criteria:

1. Must have a COMPLETED application by the deadline date. (The status on the Received Application Page on the encampment website MUST be green or yellow at that date.)
2. A few days after the deadline, all incomplete applications will be removed from the database and an email will be sent to each cadet.
3. If the remaining candidates exceed the capacity of the facility, cadets will be accepted in Rank/Age order. Highest ranked cadets will be accepted regardless of age. Cadets with the rank equal to the cutoff will be accepted with the oldest first. All cadets with completed paperwork will receive a letter indicating the final status of their application.
4. In the past, very few, if any cadets with rank of Airmen have been accepted. So, if you are new to the program and really want to come to an encampment, promote as frequently as you can. The rank as of the deadline date will determine who is accepted.
5. We do not have room to admit students who have previously attended an encampment. Apply using the NYWG ENCAMPMENT STAFF event in the Registration Zone. If you do not receive a staff position, you may be considered for the Advanced Training Flight

Additional information:

If you receive acceptance from National for an encampment scholarship, that does NOT automatically mean you are accepted to the New York Wing Encampment. They are two separate processes.

If your application status is GREEN or YELLOW (in Received Applications) that does not necessarily mean you are accepted, it just means that your application is complete. This year 120 cadets will be accepted. Once final acceptances are made, the RECEIVED APPLICATIONS heading will change from “Applications” to “Accepted”.
